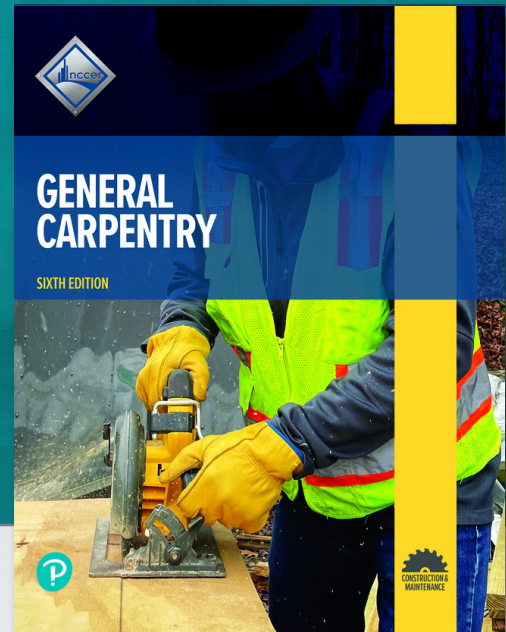
General Carpentry, Sixth Edition now features two distinct career paths rather than a four-level structure.
