
## Electronic Systems Technician (EST)

The following graph is a representation of the new format for EST based on industry-desired career paths. NCCER is proud to offer EST Levels 3 & 4, which may be taken after completion of Electrical Levels 1 & 2. EST Level 4 offers interim credentials for two distinct career plans - one for Audio, Video, and Data and one for Life Safety and Security. The tables below indicate the modules, registry ID number, and number of hours required for each interim credential. The tables also indicate the level of the craft where each module can be found.
