
NCCER VIRGINIA PARENT SURVEY RESPONSES




How do you feel about the following statements:



Thinking about your child's future career, rank the following according to how important you find it:






Elective courses and extra-curricular activities:

Would you support your child taking elective courses in middle school or high school that teach technical or occupational skills?




How strong of an influence do you feel extra-curricular activities have in the development of work-related skills?



When you think of a career in construction, what comes to mind?




If your child decided to pursue a career in the construction industry, would you be...




Thinking about your child's future career, rank "Job Satisfaction" according to how important you find it:
